- ⊕ To liaise with the TD(s) on all matters relating to NRSP Goal Keepers at all ages and genders.
- ⊕ To attend all NRSP coaches meetings.
- ⊕ To submit to the TD(s) a yearly training schedule regarding the training of the NRSP Goal Keepers for each age group and gender.
- ⊕ To submit to the TD(s) a written report once a month of their progress with the NRSP Goal Keepers.
- ⊕ Ensure you are aware of and keep updated in regards to best practice policies.
- ⊕ To produce session plans for all coaching sessions and inform the team head coach and keeper(s) of the said team of the theme for those sessions.
- ⊕ Support the development and recruitment of goalkeepers at all NRSP age groups and genders.
- ⊕ Help support the creation of age appropriate curriculum
- ⊕ Provide player evaluations
- ⊕ Be a connection to parents with questions / information /feedback
